Alex Vazquez is a Maryland Community Organizer with the CASA organization that has spent years empowering thousands of working-class immigrant families in the region and across the country. His efforts have led to organizing and mobilizing hundreds of community members, resulting in favorable outcomes for housing, immigration, environmental justice, and more on all levels of government. His most recent victories include passing a county-wide building electrification bill for new construction (making it the first in the state of Maryland) and securing funds to build the first-ever Green Social Housing residential buildings in Montgomery County, Maryland.
